- (3) In July 1947, my father was a firefighter with the Roswell, New Mexico Fire Department. He returned one night, telling the family that he had been on a fire run to the north of Roswell. There he encountered the wreck of some kind of craft and the bodies of the alien flight crew.
- (4) In early July 1947, I was in the fire house waiting for my father to take me home. A State Trooper arrived and displayed a piece of metallic debris that he said he'd picked up on the crash site. It was a dull gray and about the thickness of aluminium foil. When wadded into ball, it would unfold itself. The fire fighters were unable to cut it or burn it.
- (5) A few days later, several military personnel visited the house, telling my younger brothers and sisters to wait outside. My mother and I were told to sit at the dining room table where I was questioned about the piece of metal I had seen. I was told that if I ever talked about it, I could be taken out into the desert never to return, or that my mother and father would be taken to "Orchard Park", a former POW camp.
