Washing your spouse's feet:

Shows that you honor and respect your spouse.

Says I love you.

symbol of love and humility.

- Demonstrates a humility of heart and character, kneeling before your spouse. • Communicates "I will be here for you through the muck and mud of life".
- Places you in a position of prayer (on your knees) a great place to be in marriage.

• Shows you can receive your spouses support, and won't "go it alone" • Places you in a position of power, which we need to remember we hold, so we don't abuse it!*


Having your feet washed:


